

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.Invistics.com and Invistics and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to Invistics include www.Invistics.com and Invistics. The Invistics website is a company website site. By using the Invistics website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Invistics may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Invistics. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Invistics website.

Invistics encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from Invistics so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Invistics is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Invistics website.

Use of your Personal Information

Invistics collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Invistics may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Invistics and its affiliates. Invistics may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Invistics does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Invistics may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Invistics, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Invistics will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Invistics or the site; (b) protect

and defend the rights or property of Invistics; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Invistics, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Invistics website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Invistics pages, or register with Invistics site or services, a cookie helps Invistics to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on.

When you return to the same Invistics website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Invistics features that you customized. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Invistics services or websites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

Invistics secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol.

Children Under Thirteen

Invistics does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.
